**May's Minutes** were approved as amended.

### **Nominations and Voting –**

Jenn Brown was nominated and voted in as Treasurer

Shawn Perreault was nominated and voted in as President.

Jen Rydeen was nominated and voted in as Vice-President.

**Mini Grants** – We have \$704.00 remaining.

- Mrs. Normandin requested \$250.00 last month to purchase board/card games for indoor recess play. The membership approved \$100.00 in May, and requested that she purchase what she can for that amount, then provide a list for items she would like to purchase above and beyond that amount. She has submitted her list and is requesting the additional \$150.00 of her original request. Approved.
- Carol Cohen is requesting \$237.24 to purchase 36 playground balls for grades K-4. Approved.
- Maura Milner requests \$234.95 to purchase items for teaching the 5210 nutrition program. This program supports healthy eating choices and habits and helps incorporate wellness into the PE program. It will be used by all elementary gym classes. The request is for 2 sets of fruit and veggie bean bags at \$24.99 each and 2 sets of sun power KIDZ bean bags at \$79.99 each. Approved
- The 7<sup>th</sup> grade, Jane Colby and Reno Philbert requests \$150.00 to defer lumber cost to finish the mini 2 foot white picket garden fence in front of the school. We have \$81.81 remaining in mini-grants. It was voted to move \$68.19 into mini-grants to total the \$150.00 and the mini-grant was approved in that amount.

**Field Day** – Everything is set. Water has been picked up (1000 little bottles and 70 gallons) and t-shirts will be dropped off in the morning. The dunk tank and grill will be picked up tomorrow. There was an unexpected increase in cost of \$425.00 charged by the bus company due to the change in start time.

**Kindergarten Boxes** – Kindergarten Academy is coming up. There are 47 Kindergarteners registered so far. We usually give pencil boxes or pouches with a few supplies at the Kindergarten Academy. This will

cost a little more this year to do because in the past we have had a lot of donated items that have dwindled so check the sales for pencils, erasers, pencil sharpeners and crayons!

**Welcome Back Luncheon** – Tammy and Jenn will do again this year. The teachers return to school on August 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>. First day of school is the 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Other Business –**

- Father/Daughter Dance – There was a budget of \$1000.00 for this event. The total expense was \$1296.95 and the total ticket sales were \$1301.00. have submitted \$296.95 to recover their costs. Approved.
- We are receiving a membership award again this year for increasing our membership.
- Faith requested that we include the babysitting/mother's helper list in the next newsletter as we did not have a directory this year.
